Lesson 2: Knowing God

- Lesson Objectives: That your students would understand that Jesus is the ultimate picture of who God is, and by knowing Jesus we can truly know God, and that they would begin to look deeper into Jesus' life and ministry to get to know Him better.
- Scripture Focus: Hebrews 1:1-3, John 3:2, John 6:66-69

Lesson 3: Knowledge That Transforms

- Lesson Objectives: The point of this lesson is for students to learn that knowing God is not merely a concept, but a truth that transforms who we are and our view of God's mission, and that they would define how knowing God changes their view of themselves, others, and God's mission in the world.
- Scripture Focus: 2 Peter 1:1-9, Galatians 4:8-9, Psalm 46:10
