Jesus And Faith Lesson Overviews

Lesson 1: The Answer

- **Lesson Objective:** Students will understand that our faith in Jesus is the means by which we find forgiveness and eternal relationship with Christ; and to really consider the significance of life through faith in Christ and death in separation from Him.
- **Scripture Focus:** John 3:16-18

Lesson 2: Be Good Soil

- **Lesson Objective:** Students will understand that a faith in Christ that is pure and persevering goes hand-in-hand with an acceptance and love of God's Word; and to evaluate their attitudes toward knowing and living out God's Word.
- **Scripture Focus:** Luke 8:4-15

Lesson 3: Do You Believe?

- **Lesson Objective:** Students will understand that because of our faith, we trust in God to meet our needs according to His plan and timing, not necessarily ours; and to take a look at the nature of their faith in God, to honestly assess any hesitancy or doubt, and to go to God in prayer with their thoughts.
