

## elements | Evangelism

### A 3-Lesson Bible Study

The word evangelism sends shivers down a lot of students' spines. Why? Because too often we unintentionally put the "what" (methodology) above the "why" (God's heart for humankind). But when teenagers have a good grasp of God's desire to redeem all humankind, the methodology both finds its proper place, and becomes less of a hang-up. When teenagers understand the "why," the "how" comes naturally!

*Evangelism*, one of the studies in the **elements** line of Bible study curriculum, will help your students understand that God has always had a heart for being in relationship with humankind, that Jesus desires for us to be active in sharing the Gospel with those who need to hear it, and that they would begin to identify--and address--some of the hang-ups that keep them from being more active messengers of the Gospel.

Teach **elements** | *Evangelism* and remind your students how fulfilling it can be to live as messengers of the Gospel.

### Evangelism Lesson Overviews

#### Lesson 1: The God Of Relationship

- **Objective:** The point of the lesson is that students would understand that God has always had a heart for being in relationship with humankind, and how this fact should change the way they view other people.
- **Scripture Focus:** Genesis 1:26-31, Deuteronomy 7:6-7, Exodus 19:3-6, 2 Samuel 7:23-24, Isaiah 42:6-7, Luke 2:22-32

#### Lesson 2: God's Plan And The World

- **Objective:** The point of the lesson is that students would see that Jesus desires for us to be active in sharing the Gospel, and that students would embrace ways that they can be communicators of Christ's story in their contexts.
- **Scripture Focus:** John 10:11-17, Matthew 9:35-38, Matthew 28:16-20

#### Lesson 3: God's Plan And You

- **Objective:** The point of the lesson is that students would understand the right attitude and approach to communicating the Gospel, and that they would begin to identify some of the hang-ups that keep them from being messengers of the Gospel.
- **Scripture Focus:** 1 Corinthians 9:19-23, 1 Peter 3:13-16
