:: Impacting A Hostile World

Dear Parents,

This letter is to let you know that we've just taught the second lesson in *Engage*, the 4-lesson study on why and how to engage a hostile world with the message of Christ. If you recall, the first lesson exposed the tension between living for this world versus living for God's Kingdom. This second lesson built on this foundation.

The second lesson was entitled "Alive In A Dead World" and focused on Ephesians 2:1-7. The point of the lesson was that students would learn to interact with the world in such a way that shows their grasp of the concept that they are not really of this world, but are of the Lord and His Kingdom.

## Next Steps . . .

As you go through this week with your child, look for instances to create some dialogue based on the theme of this lesson. Consider discussing the following questions or concepts:

- Discuss with your child what it looks like for a person to live in this world but not for this world.
- Share your testimony with your child of God's transforming you from someone who was of this world to someone having a new life in Christ.
- Pray a prayer of praise with your child for the transformational gift of salvation found in Christ.

Please take time this week to pray that the Holy Spirit would begin to develop a deeper passion for prayer in your child and in our student ministry. Pray that our students would begin to understand the truly amazing grace found in Christ's work to rescue them from God's wrath and bring them to new life.
